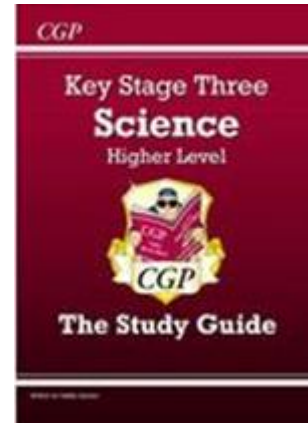

GCSE Science

Firstly, congratulations to all Year 10 students on an excellent set of Religion and Philosophy mock exam results! Students will be completing mock exams in the Summer term for Science (and most other GCSE subjects) and will be assessed on content covered in Year 9 and Year 10. Therefore, to offer some guidance and clarity, students should begin to revise the following topics using the revision books provided (it may seem a long way off but now is the time to get ahead!):

Biology 1-4 Cell Biology; Organisation; Infection and response; Bioenergetics

Chemistry 1-5 Atomic structure and the periodic table; Bonding, structure, and the properties of matter; Quantitative chemistry, Chemical changes; Energy changes.

Physics 1-4 Energy; Electricity; Particle model of matter; Atomic structure

These are the topics that will be assessed through the completion of Paper 1. Students will sit 1 paper for each of the Sciences (Biology, Chemistry, Physics) but in Year 11 Mocks and GCSE examinations, students will sit 2 papers for each Science.
