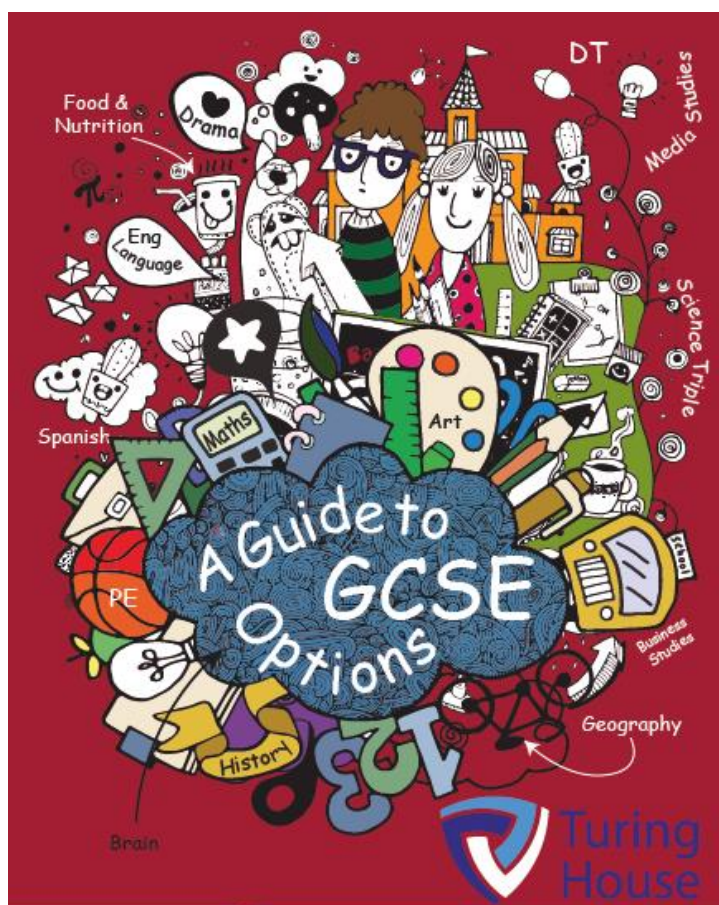
Food Technology - Year 9

Strawberry Hill House – Year 7 visit

On Thursday the 1st of March year seven students braved the snow and headed to Strawberry Hill House for an exciting day full of History and English. Strawberry Hill House is the Gothic Revival villa that was built by [Horace Walpole](#) from 1749 onward. It is an example of the "Strawberry Hill Gothic" style of architecture, and it prefigured the nineteenth-century Gothic revival. The students took part in four workshops which consolidated their knowledge of the time period and of gothic literature. They were given a tour of the house, discovered medieval medicine techniques, created a gothic comic, and designed a monastery.
